

NSW Energy and Water Starters OfferOffer Recipients

Background

With support from the NSW Government, NABERS was pleased to offer an opportunity designed to support buildings in NSW in measuring and improving their environmental performance.

The offers available to buildings in NSW were:

Accelerating Net Zero Buildings Energy Starters program – to encourage new participation with NABERS ratings.

DPE NSW Water Starters program – to encourage new participation with NABERS water ratings and water efficiency engagement.

The NSW Energy and Water Starters offer completed four rounds and is now closed. The first from October 2021 to June 2022, the second from July 2022 to February 2023, the third from April 2023 to December 2023, and the final one from February 2024 to June 2024.

Energy Starters Program

This program was designed to encourage new customers to begin measuring and managing their energy performance with NABERS and to create demand for energy management and Assessor services. The structure of the offer asked participants to commit to two consecutive NABERS Energy ratings, with an action plan for improvements between ratings.

Water Starters Program

This program was designed to encourage new customers to begin measuring and managing their water performance with NABERS and to create demand for water management and Assessor services. The structure of the offer asked participants to commit to two consecutive NABERS Water ratings, with an action plan for improvements between ratings. Participants were offered water efficiency materials and provided opportunities for capacity building during the program rollout.
