## WHAT IS NABERS?

NABERS (National Australian Built Environment Rating System) is a government initiative providing certified sustainability ratings to support the efficiency of buildings across Australia.

NABERS ratings are simple, reliable and trusted, ranging from one to six stars for a building's efficiency. Ratings measure performance of energy, water, waste and indoor environment across building sectors including hotels, data centres, apartments, offices, shopping centres and more.

A NABERS rating helps owners and managers accurately measure, understand and communicate the environmental performance of their facility versus comparable buildings in the same sector, identifying areas for cost savings and future improvements.

Over the last 25 years, the NABERS rating system has driven significant financial growth and returns in portfolios across building sectors by clearly demonstrating operational performance and sustainability achievements. That's how we know environmentally friendly buildings are not only better for people and the planet; they're also better for the bottom lines of Australian businesses.



TYPES OF HOTEL
RATINGS

#### NABERS ENERGY FOR HOTELS

A NABERS Energy rating is a measure of the energy efficiency of your hotel building's operation, giving you a fair reflection of how you are progressing against your energy-saving commitments.

A NABERS Accredited Assessor will provide a rating from one to six stars, indicating the energy efficiency and environmental impact of your hotel. Your assessor can also provide tailored sustainability advice to help you cut costs and improve future ratings.

### NABERS WATER FOR HOTELS

A NABERS Water rating measures the amount of water used and recycled within your hotel building. Similar to a NABERS Energy rating, your accredited assessor can provide sustainability advice that will help improve future ratings.

### NABERS WASTE VERIFICATION

NABERS Waste tools measure how well buildings manage waste generation, recycling and resource recovery, and supply chain management. NABERS can provide an independent measurement of the recycling and resource recovery performance of your hotel building.

### NABERS PATHWAY FOR CLIMATE ACTIVE CARBON NEUTRAL CERTIFICATION

NABERS offers hotels a pathway to achieve <u>Climate Active Carbon Neutral</u> <u>certification</u>, which is a world-leading, government-backed certification that is aligned to national and international greenhouse gas accounting protocols. If your hotel has a NABERS Energy rating of 3 stars or above and uses carbon offsets to cancel the building's emissions, you can achieve a Climate Active e and uses carbon offsets to cancel the building's emissions, you can achieve a Climate Active certification.

# HOW WE RATE YOUR HOTEL

NABERS ratings for hotels take into consideration factors that are unique to these facilities to ensure fair, consistent and transparent comparison. A NABERS Accredited Assessor will look at:

The NABERS algorithm adjusts for differences between hotel quality and size, so it's always a fair comparison. Additionally, even if your occupancy rates fluctuate throughout the year, the algorithm uses an average over the year, so you're always being assessed fairly.

# HOW TO GET A RATING

# 1. GET A QUOTE

Visit the NABERS website to <u>search for a NABERS Accredited</u> <u>Assessor</u> and obtain quotes for a NABERS rating for hotels. Your quotes will include site hours and consulting hours. Tip: To ensure stakeholder buy-in, calculate the energy cost

savings from increasing your star rating using the <u>NABERS</u> reverse calculator tool.

## 2. GATHER YOUR DATA

You'll need 12 months of historical energy consumption data and some information about the size and features of your building. Your assessor will advise you on what you need to provide.



### **3. ACHIEVE NABERS CERTIFICATION**

Your assessor will conduct a site visit to validate your rating. Your rating will be based on factors that are unique to data centres, ensuring a fair, transparent and comparable outcome.



## 4. CUT COSTS & IMPROVE YOUR RATING

Each NABERS rating lasts for 12 months. Your assessor can provide advice on how to reduce your energy and operational costs and improve any future ratings.


#### IMPROVE ACCOUNTABILITY
